

Garbage and Trash Pickup

Curbside Set-Out Guide

Garbage: Monday and Thursday

(on the street by 5:30 a.m. and removed by end of day)

Trash and Recycling: Thursday Only

(on the street by 5:00 a.m. and removed by end of day)

No household hazardous waste (paint, chemicals, thinner, batteries, electronics)

Cart lids must be closed. Overflowing carts will not be collected. Move vehicles off the street on collection day.

Carts – your carts (garbage and recycling) have a serial number on them. Each address has a cart “assigned” to it. This helps you keep up with your cart, and helps locate lost or stolen carts and return them to their proper homes. Write your serial numbers down and keep them in a safe place. If your cart is lost, damaged, or stolen, you will need the serial number for reporting purposes.

Recycling collection day (Thursdays), place the cart at the curb the night before or no later than 5:00 a.m. The cart handle should face your house. Keep at least 3 feet between your recycling cart, garbage cart, trash pile, and bulky recyclables, and make sure the piles/carts are clear of parked vehicles, mailboxes, power lines or other obstructions. Remove your cart after collection.

Electronics Recycling

Recycle your old computer and electronic equipment! The **Capital Corporate Recycling Council** is a nonprofit designed to tackle the problem of the tens of thousands of computers, cell phones, etc. that will become “obsolete” in our community. Give your stuff a second chance at schools, non-profits, and in the community while protecting the environment. We will take: Computer hardware, Computer Accessories (keyboards, mice, speakers, etc.), Monitors, Printers, Telephones, Telephone systems, Security systems, Cell phones/bag phones, Beepers, Networking equipment, Fax machines, Circuit boards (of any type), Processors, Telephone and computer cable, Uninterruptible Power Supplies (UPS), Toner cartridges, and Ink jet cartridges. **WE WILL NOT ACCEPT: Televisions, Stereos, Appliances, or Furniture.**

Garbage Cart – Bagged household garbage and bagged small trash. **No hot coals, yard waste or woody waste.**

Recycling Cart – Household Recyclables (Do not bag). **No garbage, yard waste or woody waste. There must be 3 feet of space on each side of the recycling cart.**

- All recyclables listed go into the cart together
- Flatten all cardboard boxes so the lid closes securely. Bulky cardboard too large to fit inside the cart may be folded and flattened and placed beside the cart.
- With the exception of bulky cardboard, recyclable materials placed outside the cart will not be collected.
- Recyclable Materials Now Accepted (emptied, rinsed, remove all tops and lids from non-metal containers and discard):

* Plastics - #1 through #7 inside the triangular shaped recycling symbol, including *empty and rinsed* beverage bottles, food containers, detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, prescription bottles, baby wipe containers, household cleaner and bleach bottles, flower pots, buckets 5 gal. or less w/ handles removed. **No plastic bags, hangers, toys, 6-pack rings, chemical containers, packing materials, plastic wrap.**

* Paper – junk mail, coupons, white or colored paper, gift wrap, envelopes, paper grocery bags, shopping bags w/ handles removed, catalogs, magazines, newspapers and inserts, paperback books, telephone books, shredded paper. **No plastic bags, soiled paper, photos, hard cover books, carbon paper, newspaper delivery bags, or rubber bands.**

* Cartons – *emptied and rinsed* juice, milk and cream boxes and cartons, cereal and cracker boxes (remove liners). **No waxy frozen food packaging, take-out food containers, pizza boxes.**

* Glass – *emptied and rinsed* clear, brown and green beverage bottles and food jars, wine bottles (remove top, cork and foil). **No light bulbs, mirrors, window glass, drinking glasses, ceramics, Pyrex.**

* Metal – *emptied and rinsed* aluminum, tin and metal allow beverage, food and pet food cans, metal lids. **No aerosol cans, wire hanger, aluminum foil, pie pans, non-food metal containers.**

* Cardboard – corrugated and paperboard boxes, 6, 12, and 36- pack drink cartons (flattened), paper egg cartons, shoe boxes. **No pizza boxes, plastic or foam packing material, waxed cardboard or boxes with plastic or foil linings.** Flatten corrugated boxes and place in cart or on ground next to cart.

** In recyclable cart, **NO plastic bags, household garbage, yard trimmings or wood waste, building materials, automobile/ trailer or bike tires, household or hazardous waste, electronics, batteries, paint, chemicals, oil or oil filters, soiled papers (diapers, tissues, paper towels, paper plates, napkins, pizza boxes).**

Trash – Bagged yard waste, woody waste, furniture, large household trash. **No garbage or contractor-generated building materials. Place trash 3 feet from other pick-ups**

Bulky Recyclables – Refrigerators, stoves, washers, appliances, and up to four automobile tires. **No garbage, yard waste or woody waste. Place bulky recyclables 3 feet from other pick-ups.**
