On behalf of the entire GOHCA Board, thank you for your past support of OUR neighborhood civic association. The Greater Oak Hills Civic Association (GOHCA) exists to build a great community for our families to grow and thrive.

For those of you who have been members for the past years, I would like to ask for your continued support. For those of you who are not yet members, I encourage you to join our Greater Oak Hills Civic Association and help us continue being this great family community.

Unlike other neighborhoods, membership in our association is not mandatory. But without your participation and membership dues, the GOHCA cannot continue the many good things that we do for our neighborhood. The membership dues are relatively inexpensive when compared with other associations, and allow us to provide a variety of services for the neighborhood. Almost one-quarter of our budget goes to provide neighborhood security patrols for Oak Hills by the East Baton Rouge Sheriff's department.

Other items covered by your dues include: planting of flowers and maintenance of the Oak Hills' signs that mark the entrances to the neighborhood on Highland, Siegen, and Perkins Roads; grass cutting of some of the common areas around the neighborhood; sponsoring of several annual neighborhood events such as the "ice cream social" and annual jambalaya dinner (**coming up March 21**); as well as developing new security equipment for the entrances to Oak Hills.

Your participation in GOHCA is crucial to our organization's annual budget, and will help us continue to promote the neighborhood's best interests and maintain the strong presence of Oak Hills in the community.
